Police Reform Policy

The Governor has mandated that each police department in the state complete an assessment and develop a plan for police reform. The Town has developed a policy along with input from community members (stakeholders) and posted it on the Town website where it is available for review.

Comments from the stakeholders involved in the review were complimentary of the Ellicottville PD and they represented a good cross-section of the local population. One suggestion was that the police officers conduct more foot patrols to engage in the community. OIC Auge said that he does encourage this, but will issue a memo to remind his officers to get out there whenever possible.
