## THE APPLICANT HEREBY AGREES TO ABIDE BY THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

1. An acceptable bond shall be posted in the amount of \$50,000.00 per mile of Town & Village roadway along the intended travel route. The travel route shall be established prior to any logging operations. Any deviation to the proposed travel route shall be immediately brought to the attention of the Highway Superintendent.

- 2. All log handling and loading shall occur in a loading area off the Town or Village road Right of Way. Log handling and dragging on the roadway is not permitted.
- 3. If a culvert is required to cross the roadway ditch, the applicant or property owner shall be responsible for the cost of the culvert and the pipe installation.
- 4. No trucking shall be permitted when road conditions, in the sole opinion of the Highway Superintendent, are not acceptable.
- 5. Work shall be subject to random inspection and the applicant, by signing this document, agrees to comply with reasonable requests from the Town & Village.
- 6. The applicant shall make any and all repairs to damage caused by their work immediately upon direction from the Highway Superintendent. Unreasonable delays in the performance of the required repair work will result in revocation of the logging permit, claims against the issued bond, and potential banishment from future logging operations within Ellicottville.

The Applicant agrees to accept and abide by all applicable rules and regulations.
