### Call meeting to order:

Supervisor McAndrew called the meeting to order at 6:00pm and led the Pledge to the Flag. The meeting was open to the public and could also be accessed via teleconferencing.

# Privilege of the Floor

Buffalo Solar Solutions

Mark Overall of Buffalo Solar Solutions submitted a proposal to install a 365.7 kW solar energy system behind the Town Highway building to help offset energy usage and utility bills for Town facilities. He estimated that the Town could save as much as \$47,000 per year. After 7 years, the Town would have the option to purchase the system. The panels are under warranty for 25 years and the system could be functional for up to 40. Mr. Zerfas pointed out that if the project moves forward, the installation would have to conform to the Town's zoning requirements. Supervisor McAndrew questioned if this purchase could be possible given that the Town's Procurement Policy requires that purchases over \$30,000 must go out to bid.

# **Old Business**

Valley Village

• Quackenbush Update

The Town Highway Superintendent sent a letter to the Cattaraugus County DPW requesting that they survey Quackenbush Road, as maintained by the Town.

EVGV Trail

Two Contractors have volunteered to help to dig out stumps, etc. Great Valley and Ellicottville highway departments are offering 2 trucks each to help dispose of debris created by the clearing of the trail. Regional trail meetings are showing progress.

Canada Hill Property

The Town has been looking into obtaining the gravel pit owned by Cold Spring Construction for tree debris disposal. Cold Spring would have to amend their mining permit which could take up to a year.
