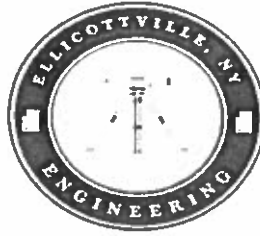

**NOTICE TO VILLAGE RESIDENTS**

Re: Local Law Involving Brush, Leaves, and other Materials

To Whom it May Concern,

The Village Board recently held a public hearing at the September board meeting and voted to adopt a new local law involving the pickup and disposal of brush, leaves, and other waste debris from Village residents' properties. The Public Works Division personnel will now only be responsible for collecting brush, leaves, and other similar yard debris for a (2) week period in the spring and a (2) week period in the fall. The periods are specified as: **SPRING:** Last week of April and first week of May - **FALL:** Last week of October & First week of November. Please note that these dates may flex due to weather so you should refer to the Village Website or local papers in season for changes.

In addition, the Village has contracted with Casella who will provide a once per month pick up on the third Wednesday of each month between May – October. Please see Enclosure #1 for the pick-up requirements. The Village Public Works staff will also be following these requirements for brush and leaf pickup.

Please note that any brush, leaves, and other similar waste debris materials handled by a licensed contractor for hire, shall be removed and disposed of by the hired contractor. All Village residents have the option of disposing of their waste debris materials at the Five Points Transfer Station in Little Valley, NY or at the transfer station in Salamanca, NY. A copy of the new local law is available at the Town Hall and can also be obtained through the Village Attorney or the Village Engineer. Any specific questions or concerns can be directed to any of the contacts listed above.

## Ellicottville Yard Waste Collection

1. Once per month service for six months May – October or April - September
2. Collections will be on the third Wednesday of the month
3. All yard waste collected will be composted for reuse as ground cover
4. Containers for grass, leaves, and other loose material must be in paper bags or 30-gallon trash cans. **NO Plastic Bags can be collected.**
5. Branches or shrubs not in containers must be no longer than 5 foot and tied in bundles no larger the 2 foot in width.
6. Collection will be for yard waste only (Horticulture debris) No plastic, metal, dirt, concrete or municipal solid waste can be accepted.
7. Maximum of 15 containers or bundles per resident
8. Individual containers cannot exceed 50 pounds.

ALL DEBRIS SHALL BE PLACED IN THE VILLAGE STREET RIGHT OF WAY  
BETWEEN THE SIDEWALK AND THE ROAD.
