RECENT WORK: Subcontractor to O'Connell Electric, Zeller Controls, was onsite 3/1/17 to address final punchlist items pertaining to the Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) system. Zeller Controls made adjustments to the SCADA program and the report generation is working properly.

PAYMENT APPLICATIONS: O'Connell Electric Company; Final Payment Application No. 10 has been revised due to math error on payment application No.8. Final payment; \$39,623.20. Chris Wall to submit revised payment application to Nussbaumer & Clarke for processing. Nussbaumer requested this information via email on several occasions.
